The problem

*Note: Earnings are split between you, the License Operator (ULO), and your Node Operator (UNO).

Submits task requests
to Unetwork.

Distributes tasks to ULOs
based on telecom
requirements.

Sends rewards to ULOs.

*Some telecom companies require high uptime for task distribution. ULOs should strive to maintain high uptimes to receive more tasks.
Uptime refers to the total time the app remains online and running (all 3 app statuses are green).*

- Above 90% uptime = lots more tasks
- Below 80% uptime = far fewer tasks
